

Quotation — Terms & Conditions

1. Acceptance & Validity

This quotation is valid for 30 calendar days from the date issued. By accepting it, the customer agrees to these Terms & Conditions. Written acknowledgment — by email confirmation or a signed quotation — is required, and no purchase order will be entered into production until it is received. The pricing and terms on this quotation are not subject to verbal changes or other agreements unless approved in writing by the Seller. Any conflicting terms on the customer's purchase order will not be binding on BayaTronics. Purchase orders received after expiration are subject to re-quotation.

2. Pricing

Prices are based on costs and conditions existing on the date of quotation and are subject to change before final acceptance. Quoted pricing assumes delivery within the quoted lead time; alternate schedules may affect price. Typographical errors are subject to correction, and minimum order values or quantities may apply. Purchaser agrees to accept either overage or shortage not in excess of ten percent, to be charged for pro-rata. Final pricing is based on final documentation.

3. Tariffs, Duties & Surcharges

Quoted prices do not include tariffs, duties, or import surcharges on components. Any such charges are passed through to the customer as a Purchase Price Variance (PPV) at the time components are ordered, based on the rates then in effect. The PPV is invoiced separately from, and in addition to, the quoted price.

4. Supply-Chain Adjustments

After receipt of the purchase order, BayaTronics reserves the right to adjust pricing, lead time, and availability based on changes in component cost, availability, freight, or other supply-chain conditions at the time materials are purchased. Any such change will be communicated and the purchase order revised accordingly.

5. Component Sourcing

BayaTronics sources components from the manufacturer or its authorized distributors whenever possible. When a part is only available through a broker or the open market, BayaTronics will proceed only with the customer's approval; such parts carry added counterfeit/quality risk, may require added testing at additional cost, may require customer pre-payment, and are Non-Cancellable / Non-Returnable (NCNR). Warranty on broker-sourced parts is limited to any warranty passed through by the supplier.

6. Material Liability & Cancellation

To meet quoted lead times, BayaTronics may purchase long-lead components and manufacturer minimum order quantities (MOQ) in advance. The customer is responsible for material purchased or committed on its behalf — including long-lead, MOQ overage, and NCNR parts — in the event of cancellation, reduction, or design change. Orders cancelled or rescheduled after acceptance are subject to charges for committed material, work in process (WIP), and reasonable handling.

7. Pull-In / Expedite Requests

Requests to accelerate delivery after quotation or PO acceptance are subject to BayaTronics' acceptance and material availability. Any expedite fees, premium freight, or spot-buy premiums required to meet the earlier date are for the customer's account and require a revised purchase order.

8. Warranty

BayaTronics warrants assemblies to be free from defects in workmanship, to the applicable IPC-A-610 acceptance class, for 90 days from shipment unless otherwise stated. This warranty excludes defects arising from customer-supplied material, designs, or documentation, and from broker/open-market components, and is in lieu of all other warranties, express or implied.

9. Consigned & Customer-Supplied Material

This section applies whenever the customer provides components for the build — whether consigned (owned by the customer and shipped to BayaTronics) or purchased and furnished by the customer. Such material must be of suitable quality and delivered in sufficient quantity, including reasonable allowance for spoilage and attrition, and on a schedule that supports the build. BayaTronics is not responsible for defects, shortages, or delays caused by consigned or customer-supplied material, and any such issues may affect delivery and pricing.

10. General

Shipments are FOB (Free On Board) Origin; title and risk of loss pass upon delivery to the carrier. Prices exclude sales and use taxes. Purchaser assumes liability for patent and copyright infringement when goods are made to its specifications. All quotations and agreements are contingent upon strikes, accidents, fires, availability of materials, and all other causes beyond BayaTronics' reasonable control. BayaTronics is not liable for indirect or consequential damages. Conditions not specifically stated herein shall be governed by established trade customs. This quotation is governed by the laws of the State of Texas.
